**Question:** Which objects could cause a 500nT reading?

**Answer:** The 500nT reading is depending on the size of the ferrous object, whether the object is buried and the lateral distance from the magnetometer. Depending on the shape of the measured anomaly we could investigate the more details of the object. Generally speaking these are considered large ferrous objects.

**Question:** Who will cover the cost of excavation of an archaeological object, say a WWII military airplane or shipwreck?

**Answer:** The one who disturbs has to pay (*De verstoorder betaalt*). The permit holder of the wind farm is liable for all the costs involved with an archaeological object. To avoid the costs of excavation the permit holder can choose to mitigate the adverse impacts on archaeology, taking into account the guidelines issued by the authorities.
